



## Charles Norman Roy

July 18, 1921 - February 21, 2021

Charles Norman Roy (born Norman Charles) age 99, of Norwalk, Connecticut, passed away on Sunday February 21, 2021 at his home. Born July 18, 1921 in Norwalk, Connecticut, he was the youngest child of the late Robert and Carrie Anderson Roy.

Charles served in the U.S. Army in India during WWII where he was an honorary bugle boy. After leaving the war, he went on to work at Burndy Corporation, where he was employed for over 30 years and retired. He then went on to work for the State of Connecticut where he was an emissions inspector. After leaving his State of Connecticut job, Charles went on to work at Shop Rite of Norwalk where he worked for over 25 years and retired in February, 2020. 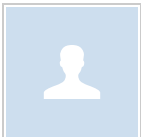
