Mr. Delmore Wesley Spence Sr. passed away peacefully at his home on January 23, 2025 with family members by his side.

Mr. Spence Sr. was born on April 11, 1941 with his twin sister Kathrine in Rochelle Florida. He was preceded in death by his parents. First, by his mother Mrs. Gladys (Presley) Spence at the age of four years old and later by his father as an adult; Mr. Joe Spence. He was reared by his grandparents after the passing of his mother. 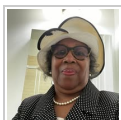
