Elizabeth was born at Stamford Hospital to the late Eldridge and Ethel Jackson on Monday, November 07, 1930. Elizabeth's mother passed away at an early age and she was raised by her Maternal Grandmother Louise Welch Robinson. Elizabeth received her education from Stamford Public School. Elizabeth graduated and received her High School Diploma from Stamford High School on June 15th 1945.

Elizabeth was baptized at Union Baptist Church at an early age. In her early teens, Elizabeth joined Faith Tabernacle Missionary Baptist Church. Elizabeth was one of the two last founders at F.T.M.B.C. Elizabeth was a Faithful Member for seventy-eight years and was affiliated with the following Ministries: Intermediate Choir, Frances Baxter Choir (aka) United Choir, Senior Choir (aka) Chanel Choir, Home Missionary Ministry, and the Annie M. Davis Scholarship Ministry.

Elizabeth retired from Bristol Myers (aka) Clairol after twenty-eight years of service as an Order Processor.
