Gregory Brian Williams, a life-long Norwalk resident, was called to be with our Lord on Friday, March 15, 2024, surrounded by love. Greg was born on September 30, 1959 in Norwalk Hospital. He was the son of Bertha B. Jones and the late Dr. Joseph B. Williams of Norwalk. Greg attended Honeyhill Elementary School where his mother was a teacher, West Rocks Junior High School, and he was a graduate of Norwalk High School. He also attended North Carolina Central University. He loved sports, playing baseball, basketball and football during his early and teen years. Following his time in North Carolina, Greg returned to Norwalk where he held several positions, his last as the long-time caretaker of Congregation Beth El in Norwalk.
