Hank received his education in the Stamford public school system.

Hank was known for his intelligence, wit and laid-back personality. He had a passion for fishing, reading and most definitely bowling. He enjoyed bowling on The Brother's 5 Team with his brothers. They competed in Nationals for 21 years together.

He leaves to cherish his memories: his 3 sisters; Florence McDougal Brooks, Nancy Shinn and Lorraine Hunter-Brown (Kevin) His 3 brothers; Donald Hunter (Shirley), Larry Hunter and Leonard Hunter (Mary Ellen).
