Early Life and Education

Born in Thomonde, Haiti, Jeanine was the daughter of Philippe Bosquet and Janette Dessalines. She was one of six siblings: Vilhardouin, Yolande, Claudette, Freda, Marie-Ange, and the late Renelle. Together, they formed a strong foundation of family, love, and resilience that has extended through generations.

Her brother Vilhardouin, who predeceased her, was married and had children. His daughter, Goldie Bosquet, maintained a close relationship with Jeanine, staying in regular contact and sharing in the family's enduring bonds.

Jeanine attended elementary through high school at the Ecole Rurale de Thomonde. She then pursued higher education at the Ecole Brevet Supérieur in Port-au-Prince, Haiti, where she earned a degree in education. This commitment to learning and teaching became a cornerstone of her life.

Jeanine was the devoted mother of two daughters, Marjorie and Gina Leclerc,

and the proud grandmother of four granddaughters: Tatiana Delva, Alexis Delva, Maya Leclerc, and Ava Leclerc. Her legacy lives on in her beloved great-granddaughter, Mila. She was a beloved aunt to Marie-José Clodomir, as well as great-aunt to Joanne Clodomir, Nick Joseph, Nady Lubin, Ginny Valery, Zaire Prosper, Ernestine Audige, Morgan Audige, and David Clodomir—each of whom was deeply touched by her grace, wisdom, and warmth. Jeanine will be deeply missed by her cherished "adopted" children, Jacques Moïses and Priscila Leon Didion, with whom she maintained regular and loving communication.

Career and Contributions

Jeanine dedicated over 20 years to the nursing profession, a vocation she cherished deeply. She earned her Licensed Practical Nurse (LPN) certification from Nassau Tech Adult School of Practical Nursing in Long Island and furthered her education by taking classes at Norwalk Community College, working towards an associate's degree. Her compassionate care and unwavering commitment to her patients left a lasting impact.

Personal Life and Values

In 1966, Jeanine married her best friend, Alexis Leclerc. They spent their early years together in the Republic of Congo, where their first daughter was born. During this time, they traveled to Italy, France, and Spain, experiences that deepened Jeanine's appreciation for diverse cultures and cuisines. The couple emigrated to the United States in 1969, seeking new opportunities. Tragically, Alexis passed away in 1972 after a prolonged illness. Undeterred, Jeanine's resilience shone through as she single-handedly raised her two daughters, instilling in them the values of education, perseverance, and love. She was known for her culinary skills, particularly her passion for cooking and baking, and enjoyed entertaining family and friends. Jeanine's commitment to lifelong learning was evident throughout her life. She believed in the power of education and continuously sought to expand her

knowledge and skills, both professionally and personally.

Legacy

Jeanine's life was defined by her kind and generous heart. She was the one who kept in touch with different family members and friends, and even the children of family members and friends. She was generous both financially and emotionally, making donations through the years to various organizations to help children in need, from St. Jude Children's Research Hospital to the Friends of the Lakota Tribe Nation and Boys Town.
