John Lee Baldwin affectionately known as Papa, was born on January 27, 1944, to the late Willie C. Baldwin and Grace Knight Baldwin in Daphne, Alabama. In 1953, he relocated to Stamford, CT with his parents and siblings where he was raised. Besides his father, he was predeceased by his brother, Willie T. Anderson; sisters, Shirley Booker and Sheila Baldwin, and his late grandmother Connie Parish, whom he held dear to his heart. John worked part time for several years at Lexus of Greenwich as a pick-up/drop-off service driver and then for the City of Stamford as a crossing guard.

Never a man of many words, but a man of great dignity, respect, and pride. John was first and foremost a man of God, diligently raising his children to be a better version of himself. He was committed to family unity and oneness expressing the importance of having a relationship with God. He was a long-time member of Faith Tabernacle Missionary Baptist Church, where he served on the Usher Board Ministry and Drama Ministry.
