



Julius M. Rhodes

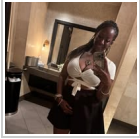
July 15, 1970 - January 27, 2026

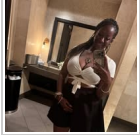


“ Hello My King,

 Thank you for sharing the world with me and our grown folks and grands.



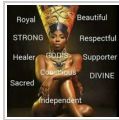

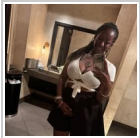

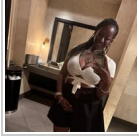

 loved every second of it. 💙💜💜💙



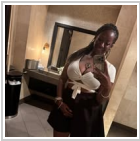
