Mary Lillian Greene, known mostly as Lillian but was also called “Patty” and “Bitty”, was born on February 25, 1923, in Gretna, Virginia. She was the 5th of twelve children born to the late Eddie and Lillie Kelly Lewis. Lillian transitioned peacefully on October 9, 2021, at home in North Carolina surrounded by loved ones.

Lillian was married to Frank Greene in Danbury on June 10, 1950 and soon after moved to Norwalk where they lived for over 50 years. Frank and Lillian shared a wonderful life together and to their union two children were born, a son Frank Jr. and daughter Lila. Lillian was a domestic worker and a homemaker until she began working in the family business where she retired from after 15 years. In 2018, Lillian relocated to North Carolina with her daughter Lila and son-in-law Allan.

Serving the Lord brought Lillian countless hours of joy. She was a long-time member of Grace Baptist Church and formed numerous friendships while actively serving in the Ladies Aid, Fellowship, Missionary and Senior ministries. She especially enjoyed attending Worship On Wednesday noon-day services and visiting the sick and shut-ins. Lillian also enjoyed sewing and had a very special gift of crocheting beautiful afghan blankets which she gave to many family members and friends.
