Mattie was a loving wife, mother, grandmother, sister, aunt and cherished member of the community. She was a faithful woman and a lifelong member of Calvary Baptist Church of Norwalk where she served on the funeral committee and where she built the foundation for her family to learn how to trust in the Lord. Mattie also did domestic work to help support her family. She was a diligent homemaker and kept her home extremely clean. She would make everything from scratch from biscuits, to dumplings, to fried apple pies and like Jesus, she could feed a crowd with just 2 fish and 5 loaves of bread.

Mattie also nurtured many of her nieces and nephews who came from Pennsylvania to work during summer vacations in Connecticut. Family and

friends always looked forward to visiting the Eaddys' house for good food and for great family fellowship.

Mattie also is known as Muh, Grammaw, Nana and Honey and she leaves to cherish three daughters, JoAnn Dudley of Duquesne, PA, Carolyn Eaddy of New York and Arlene Eaddy of Norwalk, CT, a son, David J.
