Sadly, early this year, after Maureen was successfully selected as a candidate for a kidney transplant 2 years ago her health declined and she was also a constant dialysis patient. Most recently she was hospitalized in early January and February. Maureen's ailment was very severe and could not be overcome and on February 15, 2023, the Lord called her from labor to rest. Maureen (Mo, Nanoh) hailed from the Richardson Family, the Dossen Family, the Sherman Family, the Kiahon Family, and the Manorby Family. Maureen leaves to treasure her heartfelt memories of her father Morris S.
