Patricia Ann Hood, affectionately known as "Patty" and "Pat Pat" to family and friends transitioned unexpectedly on Saturday, February 8, 2020. Patty was born in Norwalk, CT on November 7, 1968, to the late Henry and Jessie Hood. Patty grew up in Norwalk, CT, matriculated through the public school system and graduated from Norwalk High School in 1986. Patty attended Wilberforce University in Wilberforce, OH, where she earned her bachelor's degree in Accounting in 1990. She furthered her education by earning a Master's Degree in Computer Information Systems from Webster University in Merritt Island, FL in 2005.

Patty had over 30 years of Federal Government Service. She worked for the Department of Defense for 17 years at various locations. These locations included; Air Force Aeronautical System Division, Dayton OH, Defense Finance

Accounting Service Center Denver CO. Air Force Cocoa Beach FL, Air Force Space Company, Colorado Spring, CO. and the Air Force Pentagon, Washington, DC.

Patty continued her Federal Government Service by working at Environmental Protection Agency in Washington, DC for 13 years.

Patty was initiated into the Denver, CO Alumnae Chapter of Delta Sigma Theta on April 25, 1997. When she moved to Coco Beach FL, she was an active member with the local Delta Alumnae Chapter. Most Recently, Patty was a member of the Prince Georges County Alumnae Chapter of Delta

Sigma Theta.

Patty was baptized at her childhood church, St. James Missionary Baptist Church in Norwalk, CT. Upon moving to the Washington, DC. Metropolitan area, Patty joined Reid Temple A.M.E. Church located in Glendale, MD on October 21, 2007. She was an active member of the Missionary Ministry. In addition to Patty's 'parents' she was preceded in death by her sister; Marilyn Hood-Harris, and brother; Hollis Hood. Patty is survived by her brother; Henry Hood (Doriene), nephew; Henry Hood IV, nieces; Jesikia Hood, Janae Hood, Monique Spencer, and Alena Spencer, goddaughter; Jasmine Tingling-Clemmons, Godson; Charles Garland, Goddaughter; Monique Williams, stepmother; Marion Hood, Cousin/Sister; Lula Welfare and a host of relatives and friends. Pat Pat also shared a very special bond with Nicholas Scarlett and Matthew Scarlett.

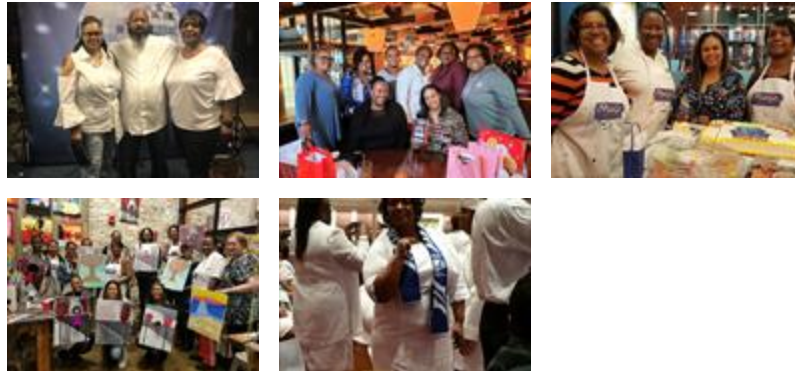

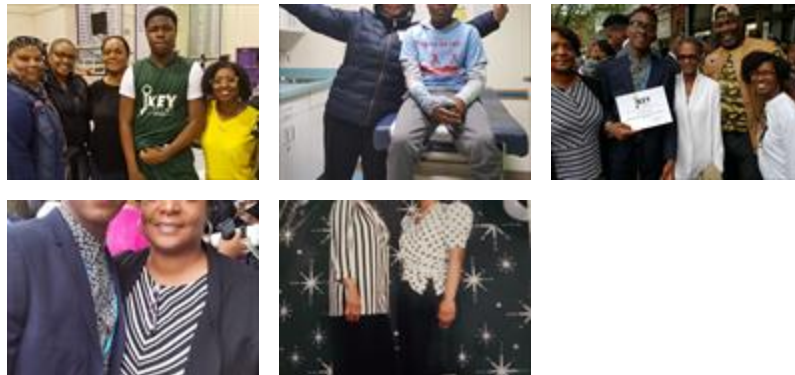
