December 30, 1971 - April 15, 2024

Richard N. Fuller, Jr. 52, transitioned peacefully on April 15, 2024. Affectionately known as Rick, he was a lifelong resident of Norwalk, CT., born December 30, 1971 to Carolyn C. Fuller of Norwalk and the late Richard N. Fuller, Sr. He attended Virginia Union University and earned a Bachelor of Arts in English and continued his education at the University of Bridgeport receiving a Master's Degree in English. He retired from the Norwalk Public Schools and continued his role as an Educator with Bridgeport Public Schools. The magnificent tapestry of his life was woven with threads of guiding the Norwalk High School Bears in FCIAC Girls Basketball to three undefeated championships and a state championship. In addition to youth development, he mentored many youths at the Norwalk Housing Authority After School Program, Youth Development Program at GW Carver Center and countless experiences mentoring and nurturing youth. Rick was affiliated with Omega Psi Phi Fraternity and was the founder of Colonial Village Garden Center. His purpose was not a destination but a journey filled with profound meaning and valuable lessons. His memory will be treasured by his loving mother, Carolyn C. 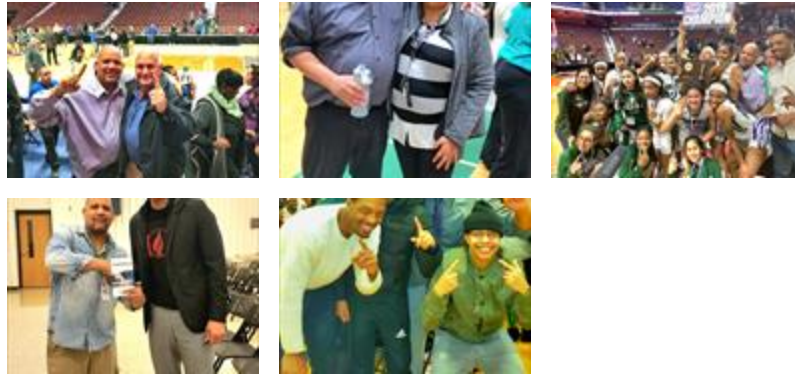
