Sharon (Quarles) Hill, long-time resident of Pound Ridge, New York, died on October 11, 2022, at the age of sixty-five surrounded by her family.

Sharon loved music, Black art, and never missed watching an Ohio State Football game or a University of Maryland Basketball game. She was a fiercely passionate and caring wife, mother, sister, and friend. After graduating from Howard University in 1979, she married Willard Isaac Hill, Jr. and worked in the financial services industry as an HR professional. Together they had two daughters, Lauren and Kimbreley and one son, Willard III (Bryant). They loved and supported each other for forty-three years, raising their children, traveling, and living by the scripture 1 Corinthians 13:4-7. Embracing love is patient, kind and always perseveres.

A true child of God – Sharon's warmth and kindness was displayed to everyone she met, and she truly never met a stranger. After many years as a member, she served as an ordained Deacon at First Presbyterian Church in Stamford, CT, for three years.
